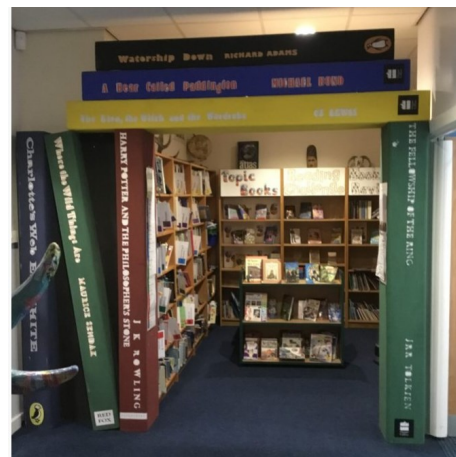

Thank you to all who bought books from Mrs Jackson on our Parents' Evenings. With the commission from these sales and kind donations from Jackson Plant Ltd, Beechwood Leisure, My Electrical, Old Red House and Vision PVC we have £700 to buy new books for the Library.

Mrs Mallett has also been looking at adding to the first reading books we have got in school. Through a grant from the English Hub we have been able to buy £1000 of new phonics books for our Reception Class.

We want our children to read more, both at school and home, to build up their reading stamina. After half-term we will be introducing a Bronze, Silver and Gold certificate to encourage all our children to read more. The School Council also intend to run a reading competition over half term.

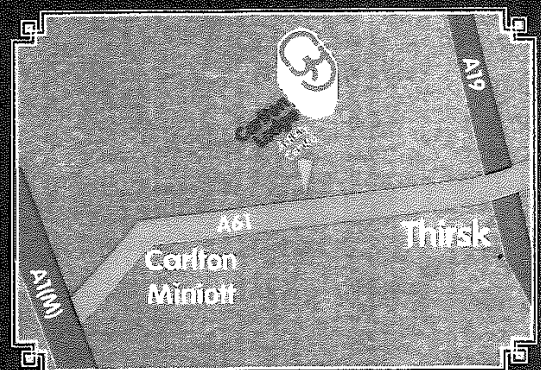
