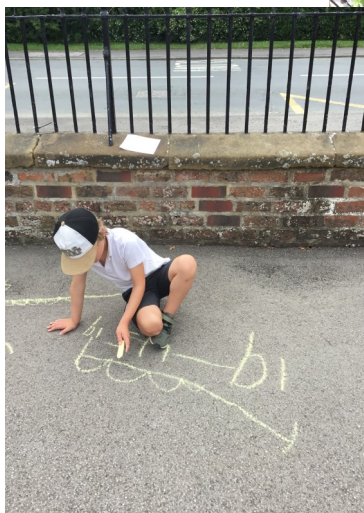

Life in School

It is lovely to hear the children in school hard at work again and enjoying their learning. I am really pleased that so many of you have trusted us to take your children back. Out of the Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 classes 84% of our children have returned compared with 33% nationally. This has been great but also means that we are almost full, our Key Worker and Year 6 Bubbles are at maximum capacity.

For next week we are able to manage the numbers but it does mean that if I have to take more Key Worker children in future weeks I may have to close a Bubble to some children to open it for Key Workers.





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Stay and Play

The staff are really keen that we get the opportunity to see the children of the year groups not in school. Therefore we are planning to hold some 'Stay and Play' sessions for those in Years 2 to 5, not in school. These activities will happen outside and you should have received a separate letter about them. Unfortunately due to the restrictions placed on us, due to coronavirus, those children already in school will not be able to attend these sessions. I am really sorry about this.

Classes for Next Year

We are yet to receive guidelines for how school is going to look in September but we are planning as if school is fully open for all children. Due to the virus and missed schooling I am keen to get off to the best start I can with the older children in school and so they will be keeping their teachers from this year.

Miss Rawding will be going part-time until 1st June, while she completes a Masters Degree, and so she will be working Monday to Wednesday and Mrs Fowler will be working in Year 1 Wednesday to Friday. Mrs Preston will be working full-time in Class 2.

Once registered they can log-in and keep track of their reading over the summer. There will be activities and reading suggestions available on the website.

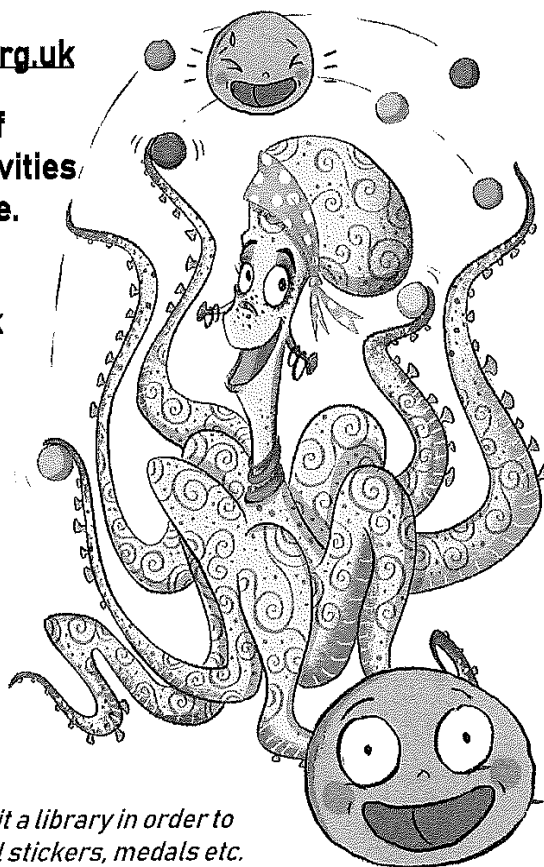
