Each family will receive a Holiday Club Bag that contains an activity book, crafts, creative prayers, challenges and activities. Arrangements for collection of this will be made once you have registered.

Each day will start with a live zoom meeting at 10am to which participants will be invited to join.

The session will start with a welcome, an introduction of the day, a live song with actions and a work out song demonstrated by our youth group members, all children can join in their own homes.

We will be setting up a private holiday club face book page, anyone who registers will be invited to this allowing them to post photos or videos of their children doing their daily challenge and any other activities for the day. We will also be posting a link to the story of the day which will be available on youtube.
