There are a number of changes from the Trust that will come into force in September.

The Trust have employed a new catering company to provide school dinners to replace the County Council Service we have now. We will be keeping our Kitchen Staff but more details and new menus will be sent out before the end of term.

The Trust are also changing the way they organise Special Educational Needs. They will be appointing a SENCO and a Specialist Teacher to work across a number of schools. The aim is to build up a team of specialists to replace the support of the local authority and improve the service we give our children and families.






Step 1 – Google 'Get Set Tokyo' and click on the top link!




Step 2 – Type in our Postcode 'YO7 4NJ' and then select your Team (House/Colour)
