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New School Year

School will return to the normal start and finish times of:-

Doors will be open at 8.45pm for all children to come into school. We would really like the KS2 children to be here for this time so we can maximise the morning learning. Children can queue down the path when they arrive at school as they have been doing.

A member of staff will be on the KS1 playground from 8.45am and then doors will be open for the children to come into school.

Drop off will start once again for those pulling into the layby. Please do not park here as you need to leave spaces for the school bus and nursery vehicles to pull in, in front of school.

Covid Restrictions for the Rest of Term

The Elevate Trustees have met, following the new Government guidance, and have decided to follow the Government recommendations that all Covid measures are to stay in place for the last week of term and therefore there will be no change to arrangements in school for the children.
