What we need you to do is:-




1) Open Facebook app and search for 'Class 'your child's class number' at Carlton Miniott Primary Academy'.

After School Clubs

These start from Monday and run between 3.30 and 4.15pm. Please collect your child from the KS2 playground after these clubs.

Text messages will be sent out this afternoon to confirm if your child has been successful in joining the Clubs they have applied for. As we were oversubscribed in a lot of the Clubs being offered, we are sorry that some children have been unsuccessful this time and you will also be advised of this later this afternoon.

Covid

Many of the restrictions have been lifted. However, we are still taking care to limit the spread of Covid. Children will still be regularly washing their hands and we will still be doing extra cleaning in school. We will also be limiting visitors into school where we can. We will be trialing Landing Days once again with Class R and KS1 where you will be able to come into school and see what the children are doing.

Class R - 18th October at 9am Class 1 - 22nd October 2.45pm Class 2 - 22nd October at 2.45pm

I would just like to clarify the new guidance we are following as it is quite different from our procedures last year.

- If a child shows Covid symptoms they must take a PCR Test to confirm if they have Covid. Children with symptoms must stay off school until the PCR result is confirmed.
- If the PCR test is positive the child must isolate for 10 days. If the PCR Test is negative they can return to school.
- Any brothers or sisters should take a Lateral Flow Test each day and if it is negative they may attend school.
- If parents/carers test positive for Covid then they must self-isolate. Your children can take a Lateral Flow Test every morning and if negative they can attend school. Please note, they must not be brought to school by the parent/carer with Covid.
- It is now not the responsibility of the school to Track and Trace. This will be done by the NHS Track and Trace Service. Therefore we will not be informing you of any cases in your child's class and your child will not need to self-isolate if another child has tested positive. However, if we have an outbreak in a particular class, we will follow instructions from Public Health England and more restrictions may apply.





SENCO

The Trust have developed a new strategy for Special Educational Needs across the Trust schools. Therefore we have a new SENCO called Mrs Merrifield who will be in school on a Wednesday afternoon.

Parents' Check-In

In the next few weeks we will be sending you information about a Parents' Check-In. This will be on-line and will be a chance for you to find out how your child has settled into school. There will be a full Parents' Evening in December. The virtual check ins will be held on 11th and 12th October.

School Dinners

As you will understand we have got a new kitchen company and a new staff team providing the school lunches. Unfortunately, we have had a few teething problems at the start of the term and I apologise if your child has not received the meal they expected. I have been working with the kitchen Manager to rectify this situation.

We will be reviewing the menu after the first few weeks and making some changes, which I will contact you about.
