Minifest - There's only a week to go until our annual manifest spectacular on Friday 7th July, 4-7pm.

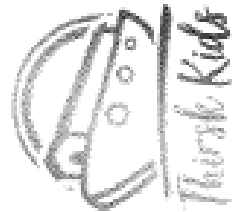
